

**INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA  
AT THE INSTITUTE OF THE POLISH LANGUAGE OF THE POLISH ACADEMY OF  
SCIENCES**

In accordance with Article 13 of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of April 27, 2016, on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) – hereinafter referred to as “GDPR” we inform you that:

Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of participating in the methodological School “Interdisciplinary Methodologies in Linguistic Research from the perspective of Polish and Slavic Studies (INTERMET)” based on Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR.

You have the right to access your personal data and request its rectification. Additionally, you have the right to request the restriction of processing in cases specified in Article 18 of the GDPR.

Your data will not be transferred to a third country or to an international organization.

Your data will be stored for the period necessary to achieve the above-mentioned purposes and as required by law.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR. Providing your personal data is not mandatory; however, it is a necessary condition for concluding a contract.

Based on the processed personal data, the Administrator of Your Personal Data will not make automated decisions, including decisions resulting from profiling.
